Charging Policy

1 Introduction

- 1.1 Bay Learning Academy believes that all learners should have the opportunity to gain fully from the experiences the Academy has to offer and recognises the real and persistent difficulties faced by families on low incomes. No learner will be disadvantaged due to financial hardship. Therefore, there will be no charge to parents or carers for any educational activity which takes place during their child's time at the Academy.
- 1.2 Reimbursement for particulars stated below will be charged to the referring school or Local Authority under Exceptions stated in section 2.
- 1.3 Bay Learning Academy will meet and respond to its responsibilities under the Equality Act 2010.
- 2 Exceptions
- 2.1 Acts of vandalism and negligence.
- 2.1.1 Bay Learning Academy reserve the right to recover part, or the whole cost, of damage to buildings or equipment which is the result of vandalism or negligence by a learner and they may do so on behalf of Goodwin Development Trust. The Academy may seek to recover the cost from the referring school.

2.2 Examination Fees

- 2.2.1 If a learner has not regularly attended the lessons for a particular examination subject, the examination fee may be requested in advance and is refundable if the learners attends for examination.
 - 2.2.2 If, without a medical certificate explaining the reason, a learner fails to complete examination requirements for any public examination for which the Academy has paid an entry fee, the Academy may seek to recover the fee from the referring school.
