Organisational Structure and Supply Chains

Our supply chains primarily involve educational resources, services, administrative support, and facilities maintenance sourced from reputable, vetted suppliers.

Policy Statement

We have zero tolerance towards slavery and human trafficking. Our commitment extends across all operations and relationships, ensuring transparency and ethical accountability at every level.

Due Diligence Processes

Our due diligence processes include:

- Regular risk assessments of our supply chains and partners.
- Clear contractual requirements mandating compliance with anti-slavery and trafficking legislation.
- Robust vendor vetting, selection, and review processes.
- Active engagement with partners to ensure alignment with our ethical standards.

Risk Assessment and Management

We acknowledge potential risks in areas including facility maintenance, procurement of educational materials, and outsourced services. To manage these risks:

- Regular audits and reviews are conducted on our suppliers and contractors.
- Enhanced scrutiny is applied when engaging new suppliers or services.
- Any identified risks are immediately addressed with corrective measures.
